## JANUARY RECIPE

### Rocky Road Cookie Cups

This month's recipe is perfect for the ones with a sweet tooth! Since it tends to be colder in January, these cookie cups allow you to indulge in a yummy warm treat. **Don't forget this is a great opportunity to earn bonus points. Just send us a picture of your cookie cups!**



#### Ingredients:

- ❑ 1 tube (16-1/2 ounces) refrigerated chocolate chip cookie dough
- ❑ 3/4 cup miniature marshmallows
- ❑ 2 tablespoons miniature semisweet chocolate chips
- ❑ 1/4 cup sliced almonds, toasted

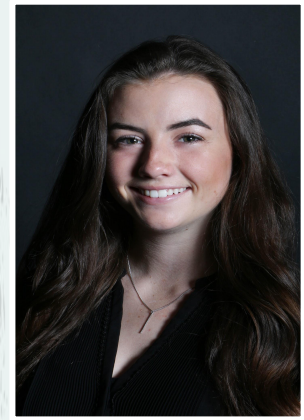
#### Directions:

Preheat oven to 350°. Shape dough into 1-1/4-in. balls; press evenly onto bottom and up sides of 24 greased mini-muffin cups. Bake until edges are golden, 10-12 minutes. Using the back of a measuring teaspoon, make an indentation in each cup. Immediately place 3 marshmallows and 1/4 teaspoon chocolate chips in each cup; sprinkle with almonds. Return to oven; bake 1 minute longer. Cool completely in pans on wire racks.
